Reference Documents for the General Meeting of Shareholders

Proposal No. 1 Appropriation of Surplus

The Company regards the return of profit to its shareholders as one of the management policies of utmost importance and maintains a basic policy to continuously carry out stable payment of dividends. The Company has given comprehensive consideration to matters including the above basic policy, strengthening of our management structure and future business development, and proposes the payment of the year-end dividend and other appropriation of surplus for the 66th fiscal year as set forth below.

- 1. Year-end dividends
 - (1) Type of dividend property

To be paid in cash.

(2) Allotment of dividend property and their aggregate amount

The Company proposes to pay a dividend of ¥25 per common share of the Company.

In this event, the total dividends will be \$1,173,949,050.

Accordingly, including the interim dividend (¥25 per share), the annual dividend will be ¥50 per share.

- (3) Effective date of dividends of surplusThe effective date of dividends will be May 28, 2021.
- 2. Other appropriation of surplus
 - Item of surplus to be increased and amount of increase General reserve: ¥15,600,000,000
 - (2) Item of surplus to be decreased and amount of decreaseRetained earnings brought forward: ¥15,600,000,000

Proposal No. 2 Election of Ten (10) Directors

At the conclusion of this meeting, the terms of office of all eight (8) Directors will expire. Therefore, the Company proposes to elect ten (10) Directors, increasing the number of Directors by two (2) to enhance the management system.

The details of this proposal were deliberated at the "Nomination & Remuneration Advisory Committee," which is a consultative body to the Board of Directors with an independent outside Director as the chair. The results of the deliberation were reported to the Board of Directors, where the proposal was approved.

There is no special interest between any other candidates for Director and the Company.

- 3. Koichi Narita, Hayuru Tsutsumi, Haruhiko Yahagi, and Hiroko Kono are candidates for outside Director.
- 4. Koichi Narita, a candidate for outside Director, previously served as a person who executed business in the Company during the period from August 1992 to May 1995. For part of that period, from May 1993 to May 1995, Mr. Narita served as Director of the Company.
- 5. The Company has submitted notification to Tokyo Stock Exchange that Koichi Narita, a candidate for outside Director, has been appointed as an independent officer.

Since Hayuru Tsutsumi, Haruhiko Yahagi, and Hiroko Kono also meet the requirements for independent officer pursuant to the rules of the Tokyo Stock Exchange, the Company plans to notify them as independent officers if they are elected.

6. The Company states in the Articles of Incorporation that the Company may enter into an agreement with outside Directors to limit their liability for damages to the Company in order for outside Directors to fully perform the roles expected of them as outside Directors. The Company has entered into the aforementioned limited liability agreement with Koichi Narita and Hayuru Tsutsumi. If they are elected, the Company plans to renew this agreement with them. If Haruhiko Yahagi and Hiroko Kono are elected, the Company plans to newly enter into the same agreement with them.

The outline of the agreement is as follows:

- Outside Directors shall be liable to the Company for damages caused by neglect of his/her duties up to the minimum liability amount provided for under Article 425, paragraph (1) of the Companies Act.
- The limitation of the liability above shall apply only when outside Director in question acted in good faith and without gross negligence in performing the duties giving rise to said liabilities.
- 7. The Company has entered into a directors and officers liability insurance policy, as defined in Article 430-3, paragraph (1) of the Companies Act, with an insurance company to provide coverage under said insurance policy for damages that may arise from the assumption of liability incurred in the course of the execution of duties by the insured, including Directors of the Company, or claims pertaining to the pursuit of such liability. If candidates are elected and assume the office as Directors, they will be added to the insured of said insurance policy. The Company plans to renew this insurance policy with the same contents at the next renewal.
