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### Notice Concerning Conformance with Continued-Listing Requirement

LIFE CORPORATION (the “Company”) submitted on May 22, 2025, a “Plan for Conformance with the Continued-Listing Criteria” and disclosed the details of the plan. The Company hereby announces it has received a notice of conformance with the continued-listing criteria (share distribution standard) from Tokyo Stock Exchange, Inc. and has confirmed it has satisfied conformance requirements for continued-listing on the “Prime Market” as of February 28, 2026.

#### 1. Company’s status of conformance with the continued-listing criteria

Although the Company did not meet the criteria for the ratio of tradable shares among the requirements for continued-listing on the Prime Market as of February 28, 2025, as shown in the table below, the Company hereby confirms it satisfied the criteria as of February 28, 2026, and thus meets all the criteria for continued-listing on the Prime Market.

## 2. Status of implementation and evaluation of measures to conform with the continued-listing requirements

The Company disclosed the "Plan for Conformance with the Continued-Listing Criteria" on May 22, 2025 and has been making improvements based on the basic policy, issues and details of measures stated in the plan.

As a result, the Company conformed with the criteria for the tradable share ratio that it did not meet as of February 28, 2025. Accordingly, the Company has conformed with all the criteria for continued-listing on the Prime Market.

### (1) Basic policy of initiatives to achieve conformance with continued-listing criteria

The Company is committed to implementing various measures aimed at achieving sustainable growth and enhancing corporate value over the medium to long term, and by improving the attractiveness of the Company's shares, it is striving to expand the investor base and increase the number of shareholders eligible for inclusion in the count of tradable shares, thereby aiming to achieve conformance with the continued-listing criteria of the Tokyo Stock Exchange Prime Market.

### (2) Issues

As of February 28, 2025, the Company's tradable share ratio did not meet the continued-listing criteria of the Prime Market. The Company recognized that the main reason for this was the high proportion of shares held by domestic business corporations and financial institutions that had held our shares for the long term, as well as the high proportion of treasury shares, resulting in low liquidity of our shares in the stock market.

### (3) Details of measures

#### (i) Expanding the investor base

With the aim of creating an environment more conducive to investment by investors by lowering the amount per investment unit, thereby improving the liquidity of its shares and expanding its investor base, the Company conducted a two-for-one share split with a record date of February 28, 2025. Furthermore, the Company introduced a shareholder benefit program in January 2025, with the aim of making investment in the Company's shares more attractive and encouraging more shareholders to hold shares over the medium to long term. Through this program, it is the Company's objective that shareholders deepen their understanding of the Company's business through gaining experience shopping at our stores, and become even greater fans of the Company.

As a result of these efforts, the number of shareholders increased from 10,040 (as of February 28, 2025) to 17,347 (as of February 28, 2026), expanding our investor base.

#### (ii) Response for financial institution shareholders, etc.

The Company has received requests from financial institution shareholders etc., which hold the Company's shares on a long-term basis, to reduce their cross-shareholdings with the Company. The Company has been responding to such requests while being mindful of minimizing the impact on the share price. In November

2024, certain major shareholders expressed their intent to sell the Company's shares from the standpoint of reducing cross-shareholdings. Assessing that the Company's financial position allowed for the acquisition of treasury shares, it conducted a tender offer for the purchase of treasury shares and purchased 7,343 thousand shares (7.43%)\* as a response. This action contributed to improving earnings per share (EPS) and return on equity (ROE). In addition, the tradable share ratio improved as a result of sales of the Company's shares held by financial institutions, etc. that proceeded in fiscal year 2025 from the standpoint of reducing cross-shareholdings, etc.

(iii) Measures to be taken regarding treasury shares

As of February 28, 2025, the Company held 12,222 thousand shares (12.36%)\* as treasury shares, and recognized this as one of the primary reasons that the tradable share ratio is suppressed. The Company has utilized its treasury shares by implementing a restricted-stock granting plan for employees and a performance-linked share remuneration plan for directors, and thereby promoting medium- to long-term management with an investor-focused perspective. In addition, the Company cancelled 8,400 thousand shares (8.49%)\* of its treasury shares on May 30, 2025, including the treasury shares purchased in November 2024 that were mentioned in (ii) above, and its tradable share ratio improved by 3.23%.

We will continue to conform with the continued-listing criteria of the Prime Market while striving to enhance our corporate value.
